Canine reproduction has long been a neglected area of veterinary medicine, usually falling somewhere between surgery and internal medicine. However, this discipline is now being recognized as a true specialty. When it comes to fertility (and infertility!) in males and females, breeding techniques and neonatology, canine reproduction gets closer and closer to human gynaecology, andrology and obstetrics. Veterinarians now have tools to thoroughly investigate clinical cases that years ago were classified as "idiopathic" (which basically means "I don't know why").
